The responses have been recorded as sd-n Strongly disagree, d- Disagree, N- Neutral, A- Agree, SA- Strongly Agree.

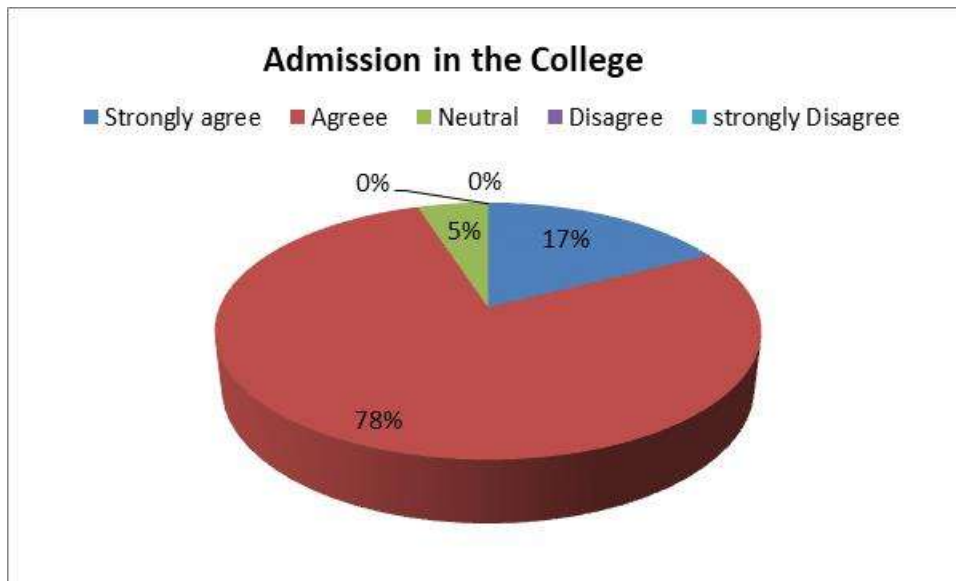


Fig 1: Parents feedback about getting admission in this College for their ward is a matter of pride for them

Figure 1 shows that about 17% parents strongly agreed and 78% parents are agreed and 5% parents are neutral about getting admission in this College for their ward is a matter of pride for them.

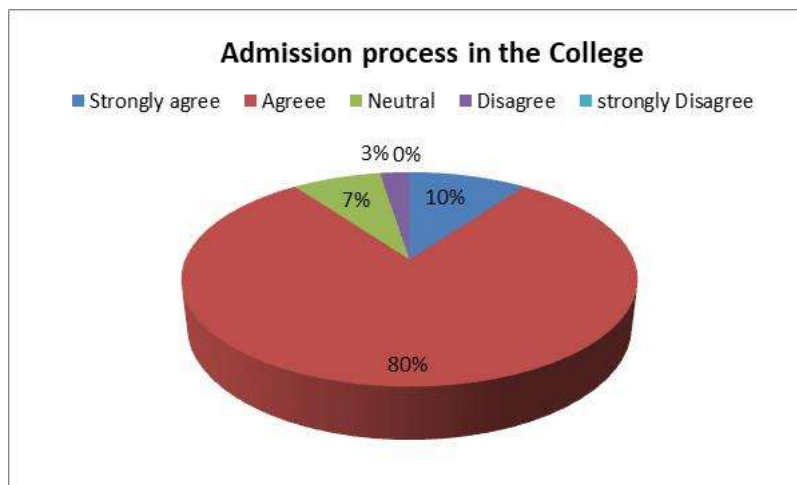


Fig 2: Parents Feedback on getting the admission process in the College is transparent.

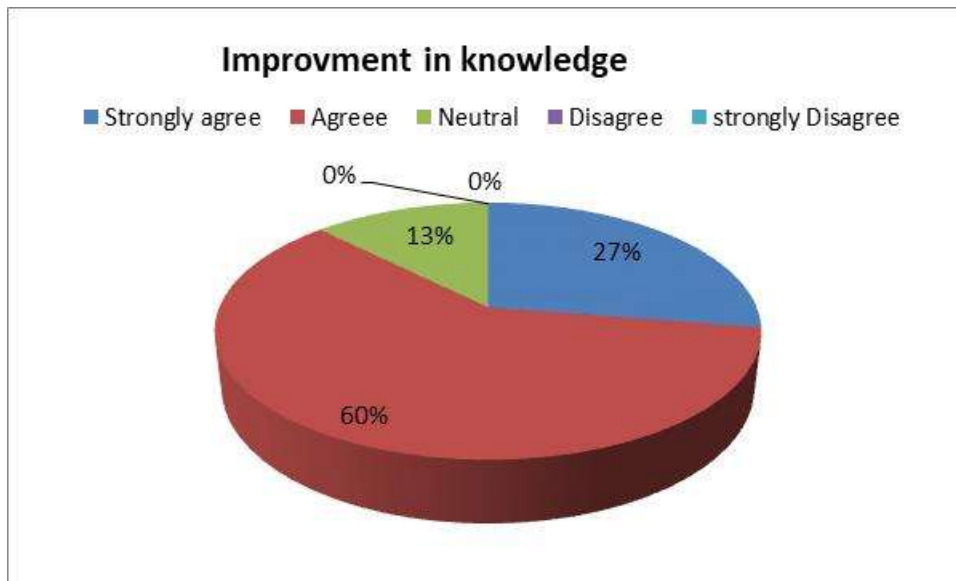


Fig 3: Parents feedback regarding the improvement in knowledge of their ward through interaction with the faculty of the College.

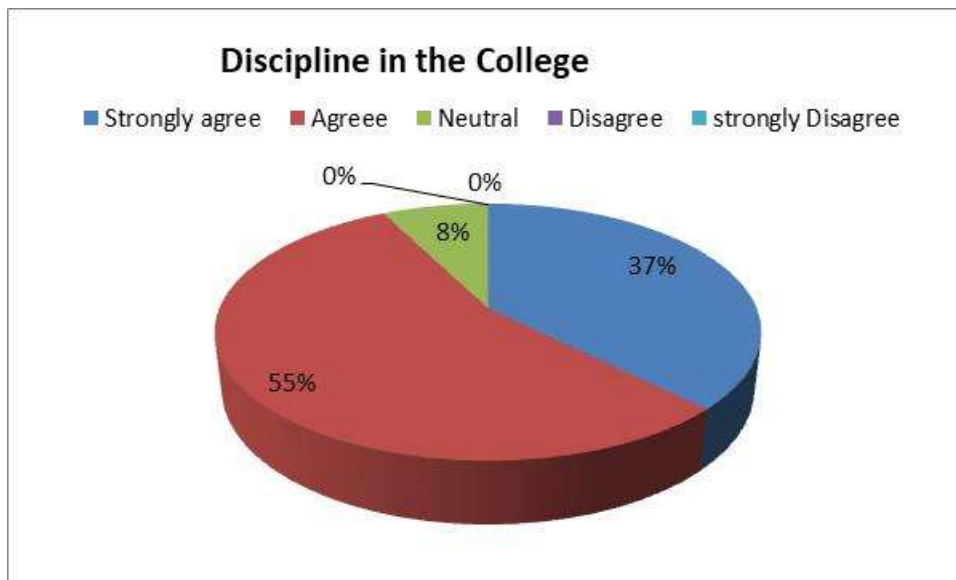


Fig 4: Parents feedback regarding the discipline in the College is good.

Fig 4 shows that about 37% parents strongly agreed and 55% parents agreed and 8% parents were neutral that the discipline in the College is good.

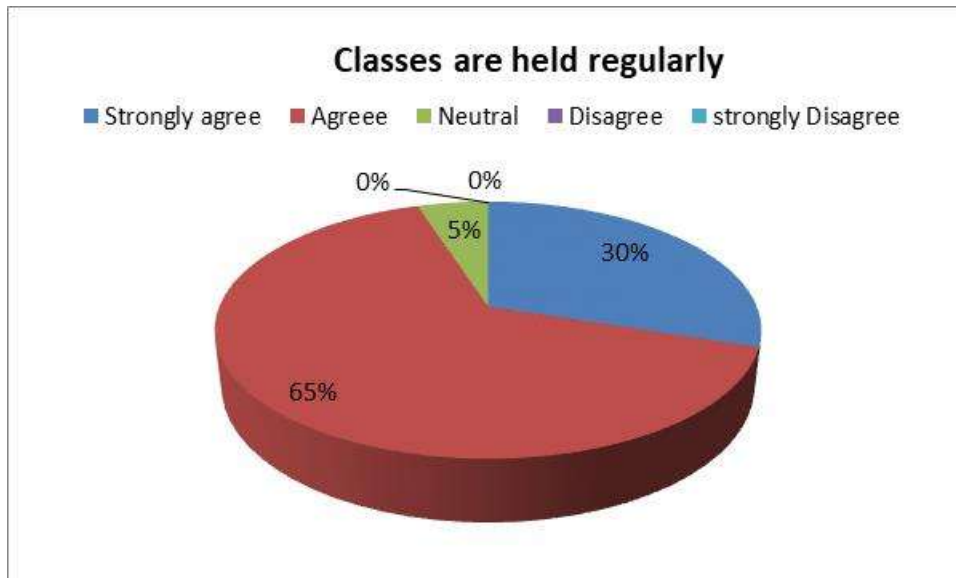


Fig 5: Parents feedback regarding whether Classes are held regularly.

Figure 5 shows that about 30% parents strongly agreed and 65% parents agreed and 5% parents were neutral that the Classes are held regularly.

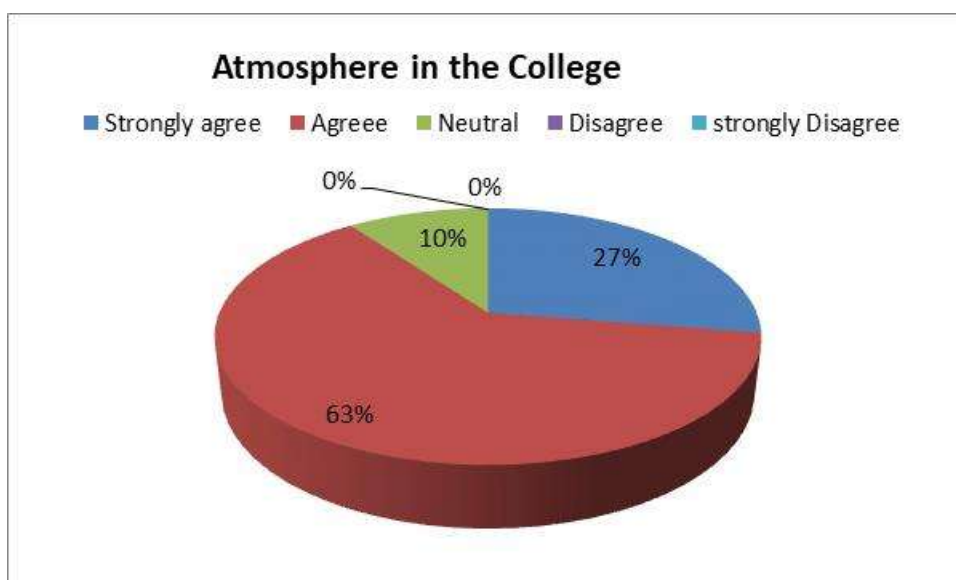


Fig 6: Parents feedback regarding the atmosphere in the College is conducive for learning.

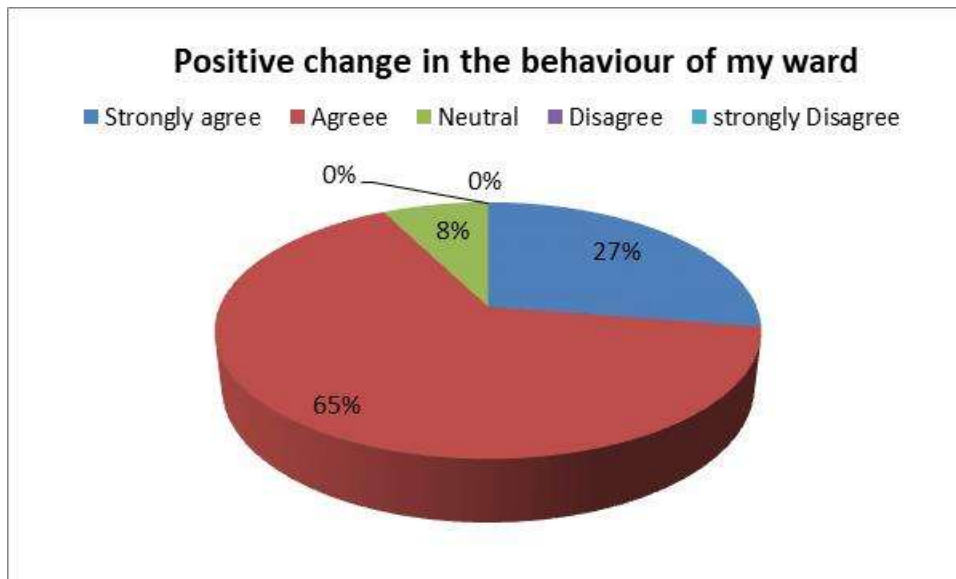


Fig 7: Parents feedback regarding a positive change in the behaviour of their ward after joining the College.

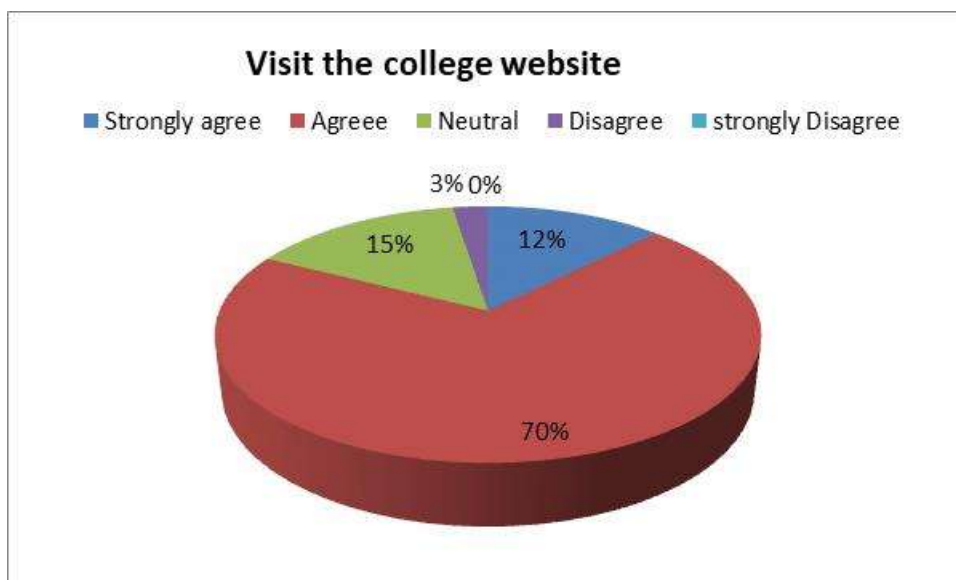


Fig 8: Parents feedback regarding that they visit the college website for checking their ward's monthly attendance

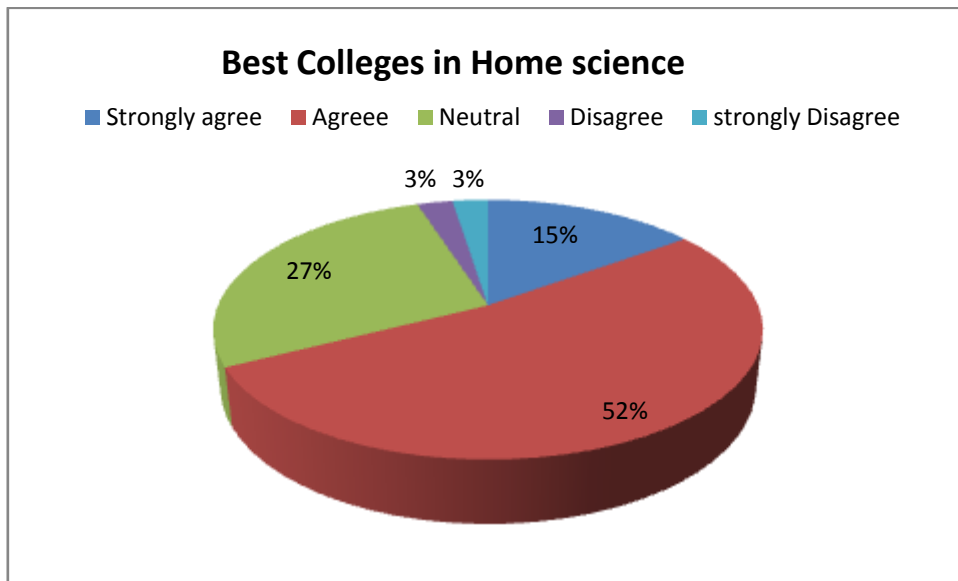


Fig 9: Parents feedback regarding that this College is one of the best Colleges in Home science.

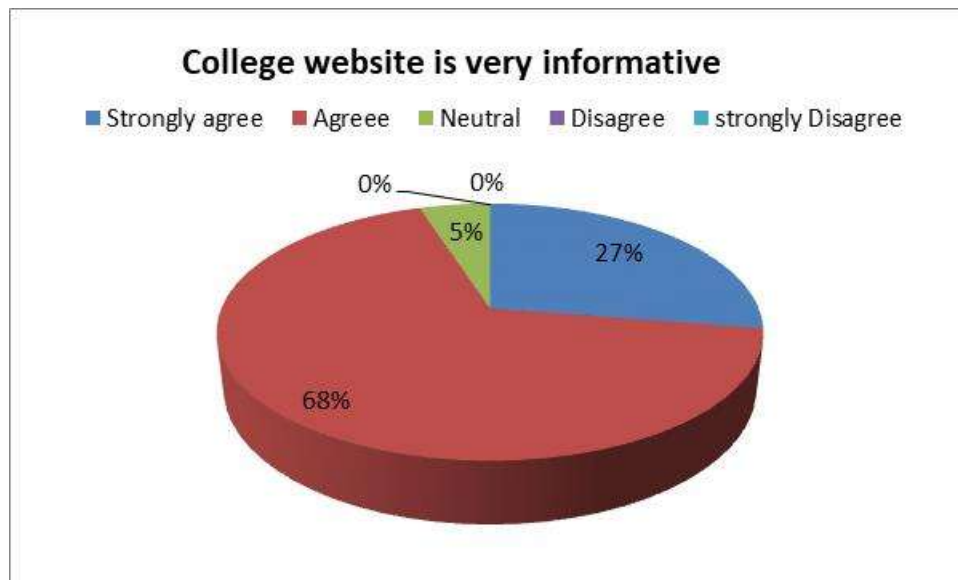


Fig 10: Parents feedback regarding College website is very informative.

Figure 10 illustrate that 68% parents were agreed that College website is very informative. 27% parents were strongly agreed and 5% were neutral in this regard.

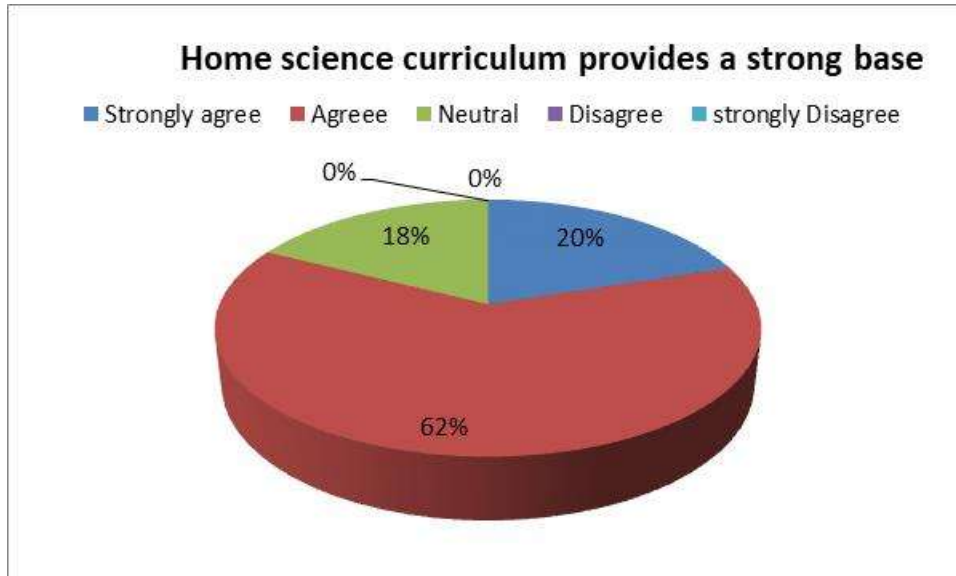


Fig 11: Parents feedback regarding Home science curriculum provides a strong base for multiple careers.

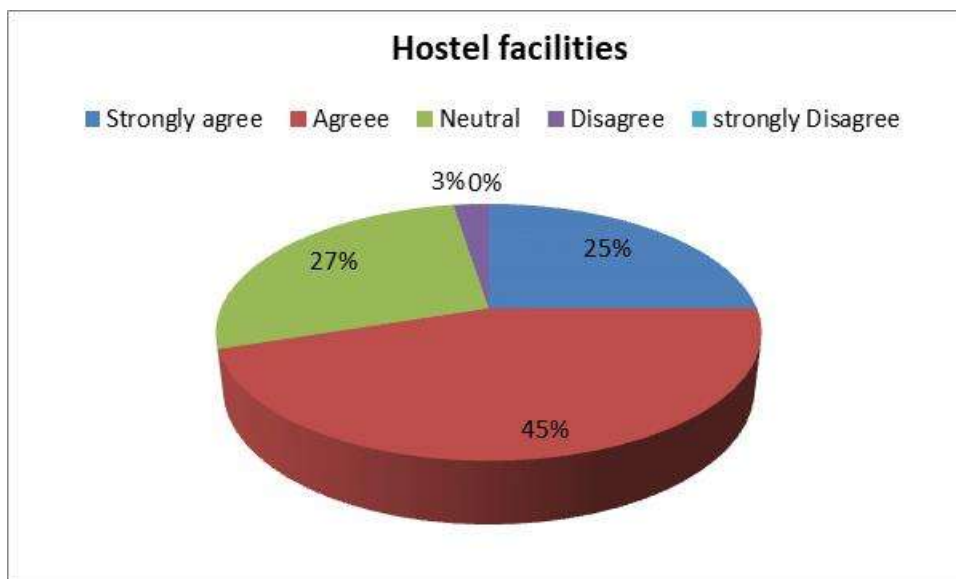


Fig 12: Parents feedback regarding Hostel facilities is good

This figure illustrate that 62% parents were agreed, 30% parents were strongly agreed and 8% parents were neutral that the changes introduced in the College in recent years are progressive.

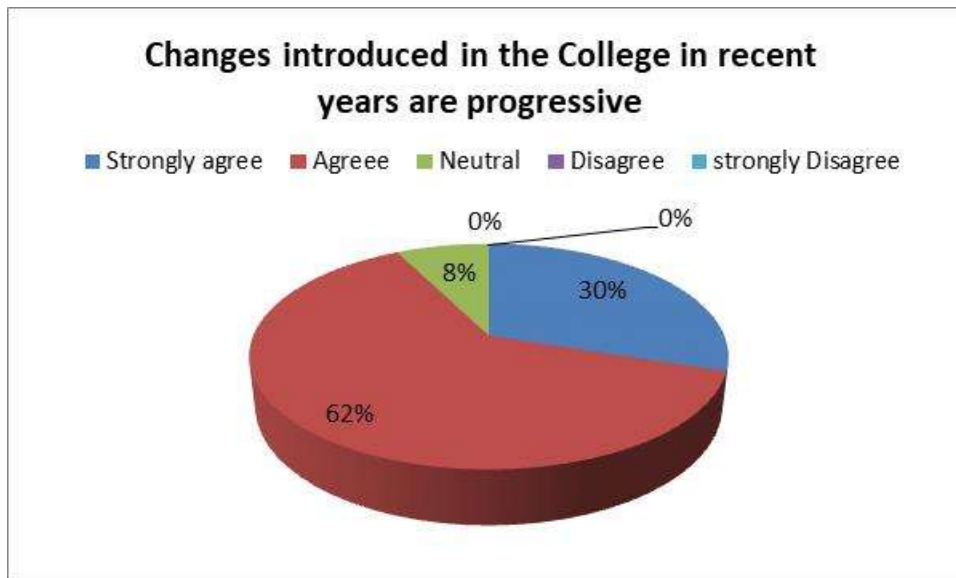


Fig 13: Parents feedback regarding changes introduced in the College in recent years are progressive.

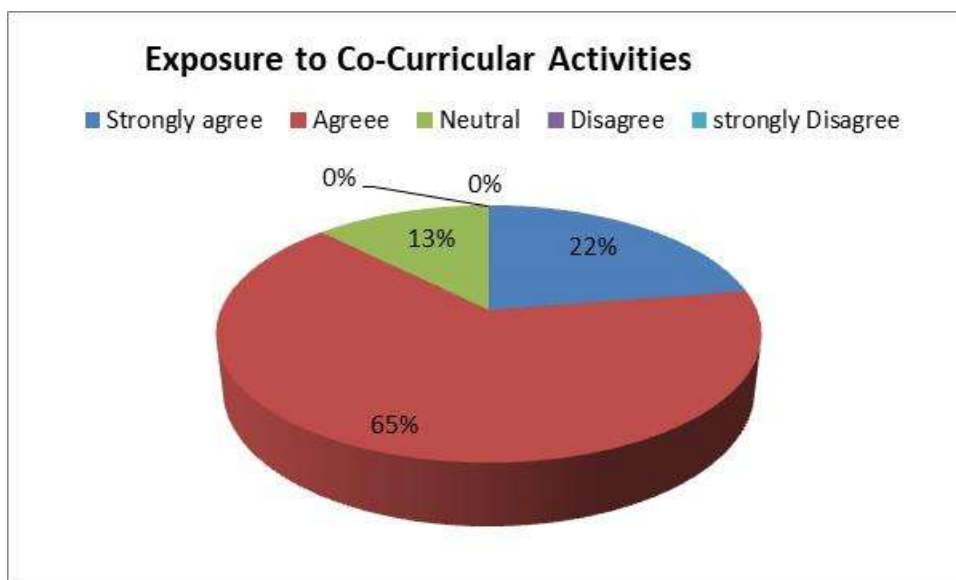


Fig 14: Parents feedback regarding Exposure to Co-Curricular Activities is sufficient

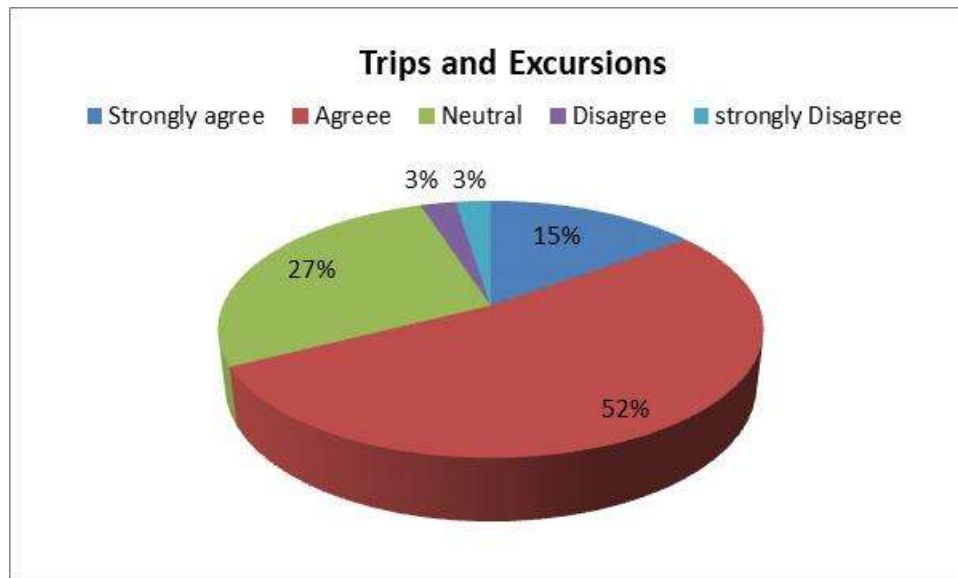


Fig 15: Parents feedback regarding college arranges for relevant trips and excursions.
