Report of NSS Activities

(Session 2024 -2025)

1. National De-warming Day (18/09/2024)

The National De-warming Day was celebrated in collaboration with the Physical Education Department, Red Cross and Red Ribbon Club. A total of 22 NSS students participated in this event and medicines were distributed to 500 students.

2. NSS Day Celebration (24/09/2024)

NSS Day was celebrated in which 127 students participated enthusiastically. Various activities such as nukkad natak, cultural performances, dances and poster making competitions were organized.

3. Drug De-addiction Campaign (25/09/2024)

A Drug De-addiction Campaign was held where Dr. Bir Singh Yadav addressed the students on different types of drugs, their harmful effects and ways to control their usage.

4. Women's Health and Awareness Camp (25/10/2024)

A one-day Health Camp was organized with the participation of 67 students. On this occasion, a lecture on women's health and stress management due to the changing lifestyle was delivered.

5. One-Day NSS Camp (19/11/2024)

A one-day NSS Camp witnessed the participation of 128 students. In the morning session, NSS volunteers carried out cleaning activities in parks, and in the afternoon session, Dr. Kailash Chander Sharma delivered a lecture on the importance of work in life.

On 26th November 2024, Constitution Day was celebrated with an extension lecture by Mr. Mohinder Singh, followed by reading the Preamble oath by the students, organized by the Public Administration Department in collaboration with NSSEducational Trip to Rakhigarhi (20/12/2024)

7. Educational trip to Rakhigarhi (20/12/2024)
